Wine Estate

Purchased by industrialist Tom Sullivan in 2016, he has continued the tradition of organic farming at this Right Bank chateau.

"I (Tom) was attracted to Chateau Auguste primarily due to its outstanding terroir," Sullivan told Wine Spectator. The 74- acre Bordeaux Superieur estate is organically farmed and produces about 16,000 cases a year. "Over the past decade or so the current owner [Steven Meijer] (who will remain as a consultant) has mastered the sensitivities of organic farming while maintaining strong production volumes, allowing us to take over a vibrant and healthy vineyard free of pesticides and chemical treatments."

50% Merlot, 50% Cabernet Sauvignon

Tasting Notes

Very pale vivid pink. Vibrant, mineral-accented strawberry, red currant and tangerine scents carry a suave floral overtone. Racy, precise and light on its feet, offering tangy red berry flavors and a bracingly beautiful minerality. Lithe and pure, with no excess weight but plenty of flavor depth. Closes stony and fresh displaying excellent clarity and persistence.

Wine Estate

The 5.5 hectare Saint Emilion Grand Cru vineyard of Chateau du Parc has two terroirs. Their vineyards to the south are mostly sand and gravel based soils. When you travel north, their better terroir is more clay and limestone soils, typical of the Saint Emilion appellation. The Right Bank vine yard is planted to 80% Merlot and 20% Cabernet Franc. The vines are on average 25 years of age.

Tasting Notes

Moderate oak on the nose, with licorice, black cherry and cocoa to help mellow out the strong espresso notes. Round, plush and forward, with a sweet, black raspberry, dark plum

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Vignification

Aged 12 months in Cement/concrete vats only, which allows a beautiful fruits extraction and then gives a fresher, cleaner aromatic profile to the wine. Concrete vats will produce a natural and gradual oxygenation of the wine similar to what barrels do but without the flavors of oak.

Tasting notes

Most people are intimidated by Bordeaux's reputation for fine, sophisticated, and expensive wines. This is not the case. Chateau Auguste Bordeaux Rouge is approachable and exquisite in the whole sense of the word. Well-balanced, well-structured, and rich with soft, fresh black fruit and soft integrated tannins, this wine has aromas and flavors of blackberry, blueberry, dark plum, black cherry, licorice, and cedar, with a persistent finish.

Winemaking Notes

The wine is made in concrete vats by pumping over. It is fermented at 80°F. Extraction occurs at the beginning of fermentation in order to keep its fresh fruit flavors and elegant structure.

Vineyard Notes

Princess Gaby is the second wine of Chateau Gaby, located in Canon-Fronsac on the Right Bank of Bordeaux, France. For years, wines from this appellation have been considered an insider's secret. But, recently, their quality is attracting attention around the world. Chateau Gaby and Chateau Gaby Cuvée are produced entirely from older vines grown on the limestone-rich hills of the Gaby estate, making them some of the finest wines in Bordeaux

Tasting Notes

Princess Gaby is a blend of 80% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Franc, and 10% Cabernet Sauvignon. Well-balanced with elegant flavors and fine tannins, the wine tastes of transformation. Strong on the nose with red fruits and licorice notes, Princess Gaby softens on the palate with a long finish and traces of vanilla. To add complexity, Princess Gaby is aged in barrels used to make the award-winning Chateau Gaby. The wine's exceptional character is derived from Canon-Fronsac's privileged climate, silica clay soil, and the expertise of a passionate team. At Chateau Gaby, we believe in pampering the grape as a whole fruit and respecting the environment. Our vintner works to pursue organic initiatives for the 20,000 bottles of Princess Gaby produced each year.

Tasting Notes:

An intense rd violet colour that gives aromas that remind us of ripe red fruits and cherries. A full taste, refreshing with excellent balance, pleasant acidity and a medium - long finish.

MARCHIGUE PANUL SAUVIGNON
BLANC- WHITE WINE

Tasting Notes:

An intensely fruity wine with a plethora of aromas that remind us of lime, grass and tropical fruits. A full taste, intensive with pleasant acidity and long finish.

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
